- Content, guest contributor and/or speaker subject to approval by the RH-ISAC
- The briefing is open to non-RH-ISAC members (i.e., security practitioners at consumer-facing companies). Associate Members are encouraged to promote the event on LinkedIn and tag @Retail&Hospitality ISAC.
- Presenters **may not** name member companies or use their logos in their briefing. Instead, please keep all examples anonymous with descriptions like “an enterprise-size retailer” or “a mid-size hotel chain.”
- If two Associate Members are presenting, each Associate Member will have 15 minutes to present. If one Associate Member is presenting, they will receive the full 30 minutes to present.
- Presenters are expected to prepare and share PPT slides, and be on camera for their briefing. We recommend 6-8 slides, but please **do not** use transitions or animations – keep it clean and straightforward.
- We **do not** have dedicated time for Q&A, but presenters (and their teams) are allowed to answer questions in the chat, as appropriate.
- RH-ISAC will send post-briefing communications to the Analyst Community, including the recording, PPT slides, Tech Marketplace listing, and any additional reports/resources provided by Associate Member.
